- Attend a 2-hour orientation class to learn about the hospital's mission, vision, and values as well as policies such as patient safety and patient confidentiality
- Make a time commitment for scheduling purposes

Being a volunteer has many rewards, including being part of the NRMC family. Volunteers are invited to attend hospital functions including the annual Christmas Party, charitable events, and other activities. Volunteers also are encouraged to participate in health screenings. As a way of saying thank you, the hospital treats all volunteers to a complimentary meal on the days they volunteer at least 4 hours.
